

EMBOSSED TISSUE CLOUDS

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MATERIALS REQUIRED

Chipboard (I used Scrapware Clouds)
Modge Podge
Stiff Paint Brush
Ink
Embossing Powder
and Tissues



LET'S GET STARTED ...

Start by scrunching the tissue paper, then
tear it into small pieces.



Using a stiff brush, apply a coat of modge podge to your [chipboard](#), and then apply the tissue paper.

Scrunch the paper as little or as much as you like, while you are sticking it down, depending on the look you are after.



Continue to apply modge podge and tissue paper, up to 2-3 layers, finishing off with a layer of modge podge.

Apply firm pressure with your brush, with quite liberal modge podge around the edges, and the overhanging bits of the tissue paper should fall away from the edges of the [chipboard](#).

Allow the [chipboard](#) to dry, and trim any overhanging bits of tissue paper that remain.



You can now add some embossing over the top of your [chipboard](#).

Swipe the chipboard with white ink, then sprinkle with clear embossing powder, and heat set it.



Take your favourite script or flourish [stamp](#), and stamp the image on the chipboard using [versamark](#) or similar.

Sprinkle it with [embossing powder](#) (I used gold), then heat set it.



And there you have it ... some funky embossed chipboard clouds.

You can experiment with this technique using a variety of different chipboard shapes, and endless combinations of colours
