

# COLOURING CHIPBOARD WITH INKS

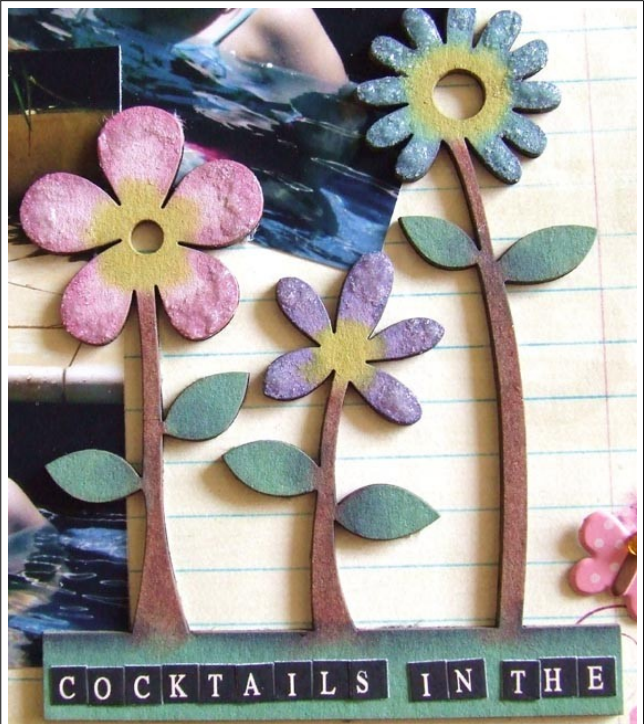
### MATERIALS REQUIRED

Chipboard shapes (I have used Buzz and Bloom Arboretum: up the Garden Path)

Inks (I have used versacolor inks)

Sponge makeup applicators (little cheapies are fine)

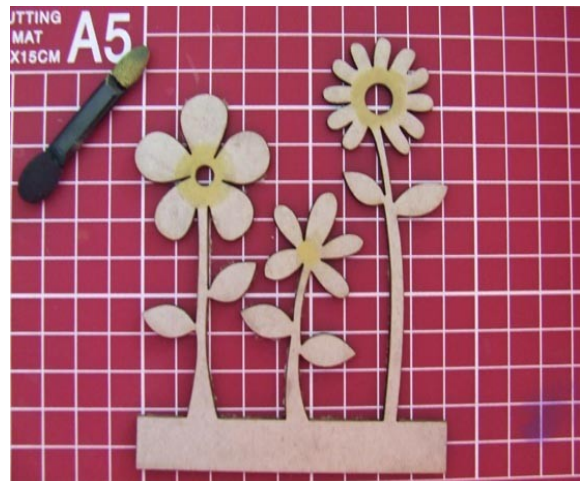
Distress Stickles (optional)



## LET'S GET STARTED ...

Starting at the centre, LIGHTLY AND GENTLY shade the different colours on to the areas you wish them to go.

You will gradually build up the colour as we go along



At this stage it doesn't have to look perfect!



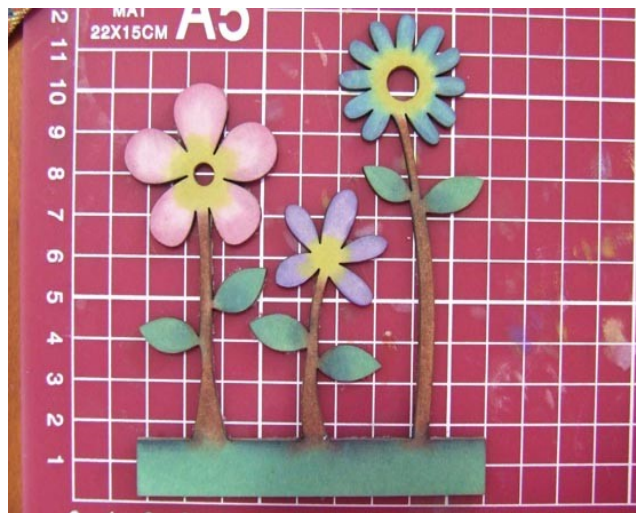
Start building up the colour intensity by gently stroking more layers of colour over each section.

Feather the edges where colour meets by dabbing the colour on gently



Add a darker tone to the very edges to give a sense of depth.

(If you do not have a darker tone of the colour you have used, then LIGHTLY shade with black ink as I have done on the bottom near the stems.



**Optional:**

If you wish to further embellish your chipboard, dab the very edges of your shape with a glitter glue or distress stickles (I have used [rock candy distress stickles](#)).
