

LADYBUG EMBELLISHMENT

A really cute embellishment for your card or layout which literally took no more than 5 minutes to make

MATERIALS REQUIRED

[Black Cardstock](#)

[White Cardstock](#)

[White Gel Pen](#)

Black Pen

[Large my2angels Red Button](#)

[Ribbon](#)

[Rhinestones](#) (optional)

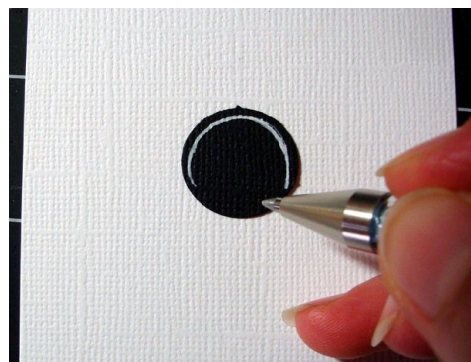


LET'S GET STARTED

Firstly punch out a small circle (2cm diameter) from [black cardstock](#).

Use a [white gel pen](#) to draw an outline around one half of the circle as shown

Stick this down onto a scrap of [white cardstock](#).



Grab your large red button, turn it over so that the flattest side of the button is facing up.

Apply adhesive to the underside and mount over your small black circle.

Leave some of the black showing as this is the ladybug's head.



Now use larger circle punch (or template) and punch another circle from black cardstock.

Use either a craft knife and ruler or your scissors to then slice this circle down the middle.

Outline the two halves again with the white gel pen and adhere on top of the button to form the wings.



Grab a black pen, draw two antennae on the ladybug's head and place two small clear rhinestones to embellish.

You can also add two larger rhinestones in the button holes to add more bling if you wish (see photos).



OK, now grab some scallop decorative scissors and cut around your ladybug to create a tag.

You can do a rectangle, square, circle or even heart shape.

If you wish you can also rule a black outline around the whole tag with a ruler and black pen. Finally, punch a small hole in the top and tie ribbon to finish.
