

# MAKE YOUR OWN PENCILS

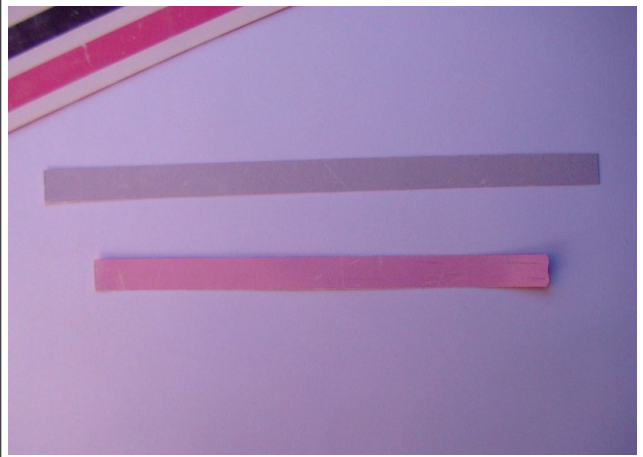


Cut 1 strip approximately 17cm long x 1cm wide – these measurements are only guides and worked with the stripes on the pattern paper I was using

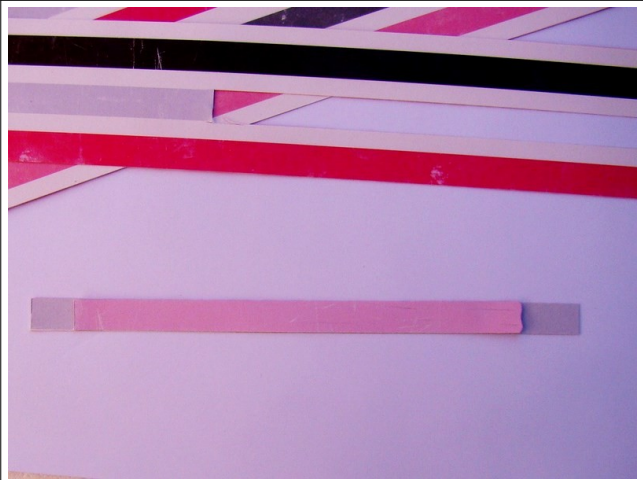
It also doesn't matter if they are too long as they can be trimmed in step 3-5



Cut 2<sup>nd</sup> strip approximately 15cm x 1cm then cut a wave at one end (this is your lead end)



Tape the shorter strip on top of the longer piece leaving approximately 1cm at each end

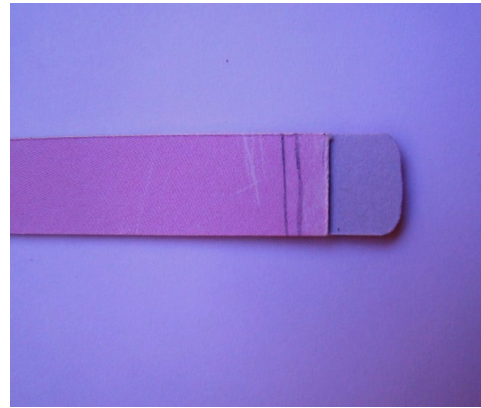


Working with the end that has the wave cut  
Cut a point at the end and using a pencil colour the tip in  
I also lightly drew a few lines toward the tip



On the other end of your pencil round the edges for your rubber

and lightly draw a couple of lines, to replicate the metal piece on pencils



I twisted some [Pink Bakers Twine](#) around the pencils with our [ruler](#) and [scissors](#) charms to finish them off
