

Rosette by Wendy Turner



Instructions

To make the rosette like the one on this card you will need:

A strip of Patterned Paper 4x30cm

2 small circles for the front and back of the rosette

Dimensional Magic or like adhesive

Rub-On , embellishment, button or brad for centre

Score your strip of paper at 1cm intervals

Then concertina fold along the score marks

Join the two ends together with double sided tape or glue, making sure the valley and peaks match perfectly. You may need to cut off one of the folds.

Now this is the trickiest part ... you need to 'scrunch' the paper into the rosette shape and it bounces back really quickly so glue one of your circles first before trying to 'scrunch'! When you have your rosette shape, put it on the glued circle and hold it until it has stuck



Then stick another circle on the front, again hold until it has stuck well



You can now add your embellishment.

For the rosette on my card I used a rub-on sentiment on a die cut circle of matching card

On this one I am using a my2angels Round Acrylic Charm

I have also inked the edges and the ridges of the rosette with a brown ink



Here are the finished rosettes

I also made a mini one as another variation 2cm in width with scalloped edges

On the mini one I have used one of my2angels new Timepieces in Beige & Brown
