



IDEAS FOR USING LOOSE RHINESTONES

Dot points for journalling

Create the outline for a journalling spot eg draw lines inside the shape to write your journalling

Create your own flourishes:

Stamp or draw onto tracing paper, mark your dots, then position it on your page where you want it to go. Then, using a needle, prick thru the tracing paper and your page to place a tiny pinhole where you want to stick down your rhinestone. Once you have poked out the entire design, lift off the tracing paper and adhere rhinestones. (this one is a good one if you don't want to fiddle with rubbing out drawing marks/don't like seeing the faint versamark or don't like the repositional glue from the acetate style.)

Or put your flourish face down on your scanner. Scan and save to your computer. Print this sheet out and this will be your template. You can also change the sizes of your flourishes too.

Centre flowers



Or you can use more than one in the flower centre.

Create a cluster using same colours or different colours



or create a flower stem with them



Cover chipboard with rhinestones

Ink your chipboard the same colour as the rhinestones(I used Scrapware Swallows)

Apply liquid glue (I use Dimensional Magic) then add rhinestones



This is the outer piece from Scrapware Christmas Tree covered in rhinestones.

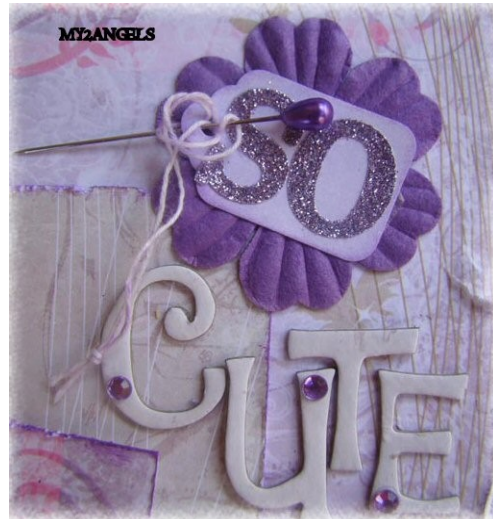
The inner piece was inked and covered with pink kindy glitz



Add to your title randomly

OR

When creating a title, emboss your letters and when the embossing powder is still molten, gently push loose rhinestones in and they will adhere as the powder dries.
No glue needed!



Accent flowers on your pattern paper



Applying them to the centre of butterflies



Create a border or circle



Create a butterfly/insect/snail trail with loose rhinestones and either stitching or dashed lines with a gel pen



Embellish rubons or mask images with loose rhinestones (like Basic Grey bling it rubons except a fraction of the price when done yourself!!!!)



Bling up printed transparencies such as this Chandelier



Create photo corners with loose rhinestones either by themselves or as part of a design
